What kind of batteries do solar garden lights use?

This saves a lot of space which is a bonus in solar lights where you don't want to have lots of small batteries packed in next to each other. In cheaper solar garden lights the batteries are most likely to be Nickel based. This could be either Nickel Cadmium (NiCd) or Nickel Metal Hydride (NmH).

When should I replace my solar light batteries?

Another smart way to figure out if it's time to replace your solar light batteries: is just to switch them to a different light! Grab the batteries from the solar light that's not performing well and put them into another one that's been lighting up just fine.

Can I mix two types of solar light batteries?

No, don't mix the two types of solar light batteries within the same unit. The one thing to always bear in mind is to replace all the exhausted batteries in your solar lights. If there are two NiCad batteries in your solar lights, replace both of them with a set of NiCad or NiMH batteries.

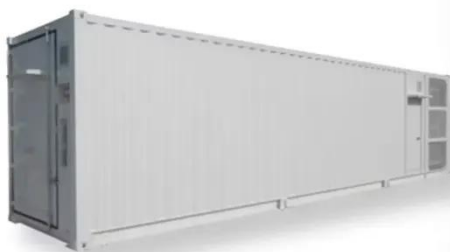

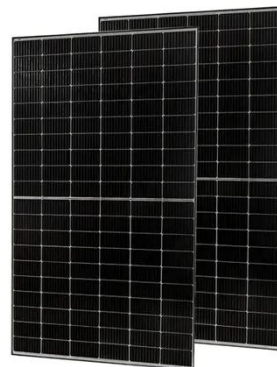

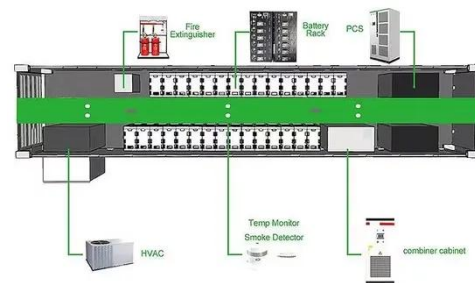
