

For a typical household, solar panels cost roughly $\[\in \] 7,000 \]$ to $\[\in \] 10,000 \]$. This takes into account the government grant of up to $\[\in \] 1,800 \]$. Prices vary depending on how many panels you need, whether you're adding a solar storage battery etc.

How long do solar panels last in Ireland?

It typically takes around 5-6 years to recoup the cost of solar panels in Ireland. After that, you can enjoy free electricity for the remaining lifespan of your panels. Most solar panels come with a 25-year warranty, so you should be getting renewable energy from your roof for at least that long.

Are solar panels a good investment in Ireland?

With government grants, reduced energy costs, and low maintenance requirements, solar panels are a smart investment for both homeowners and businesses in Ireland.

How much does a solar grant cost in Ireland?

The grant can reduce the cost of solar panels in Ireland by 25% or even more, and so it's a gamechanger for a typical family looking to go solar. In 2024, the maximum solar grant amount is epsilon1,800, but that will be going down by epsilon300 to epsilon1,800 at the start of 2025. Find out more in our Irish solar grants guide.

How much energy does a solar system use in Ireland?

Well, the average Irish household uses around 4,200 kWh of electricity per



year. If you really want to get value out of your new solar system, you should aim to cover at least 75% of your energy consumption – meaning that average home would need 8–10 panels, most likely with a 4kW system or higher.

How can solar panels help a home in Ireland?

Solar panels can provide up to 70% of your household's energy needs, resulting in: Thanks to the Micro-generation Support Scheme (MSS) and Clean Export Guarantee (CEG), Irish homeowners can now earn money by exporting unused electricity back to the grid.


